


Wision 2024



Volunteers are a vital part of our team, in fact they're a significant reason to our church running smoothly and effectively on any given week. This year we have seen over 140+ volunteers serving within 16 different departments. We could never reach the people we have reached without all of our incredible volunteers who sacrificially give up there time. Something that makes volunteers even more remarkable is that they often go unrecognised. Our volunteers are willing to humbly serve Christ and their brothers and sisters without ever expecting to shine in the spotlight.

Volunteering at church is vital for sustaining a healthy ministry and fulling the mission to reach those around us. When everyone does a little, it becomes a lot.
- 2. Serving others should be a natural response to a believer's love for God and a desire to help the church to embrace those who come through our doors. The world is full of people with needs: physical, emotional, financial and spiritual (just to name a few). Yet the church has always been an instrument and a beacon of hope to those in our city. The more you fall in love with God, the greater your love for people will develop. It's a natural response to loving Jesus and loving His people.
- 3. Be a contributor. Most people want to be involved in a cause that is bigger than themselves. Contributing to the greater good of the world and their community leads to a sense of purpose and fulfilment. Be someone who contributes than someone who simply takes. Matthew 20:28 (NLT) "for even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others"

If God has been speaking to you about serving we would love to have you partner with us and serve our community this year in 2024. We are anticipating greater things for our church corporately and personally. Tithes & Offerings

At Dunamis Church we are enthusiastic about surrendering our lives to Jesus through our time, skills, relationships and finances. We believes in the biblical financial principles that Jesus taught. We teach on the value of 'giving, sowing and reaping' and we give everyone an opportunity to do so through our church in various ways of tithes and offerings.

Here are some biblical reminders as to why we give:

- It is an act of honour and obedience, when we give the first and best of everything we own (Proverbs 3:9-10)
- It acknowledges that God is our provider (Philippians 4:19)
- It is an opportunity to imitate God's generosity (Ephesians 5:1)
- It maintains that our possessions do not control or define us (Luke 12:34)
- It is one of the ways God involves us in the good work He does throughout the earth (Philippians 2:13)

And ultimately our giving does three things:

- 1. Our generosity directs and defines our heart
- Our giving provides for the mission to reach and empower people with the promise of Jesus
- 3. Our giving unlocks supernatural blessing in our lives.

If God has been speaking to you in stewarding the gift of generosity, there are many opportunities to sow financially into our church. Wether that be through tithes and offerings, individual department and group meetings, monthly Parable of the Talents, Dunamis Community Care and other various projects that continue to arise within our church.

Parable of the Talents

In late April 2014 Pastors Shaun and Sandra released \$500 to five people in \$100 amounts. Inspired by the Parable of the Talents they encouraged people to take that \$100 and multiply it and return it with their increase after one month. At the end of that May, the \$500 they initially released together with the increase became a total of \$1500.00. Continuing almost 10 years later, we have seen over \$268,401.00 returned from incredible stewardship within our Church.

Pastors Shaun and Sandra are looking for men and women to join with them and help build a bridge of financial increase for our church. No one can build the whole bridge alone, but we can all be apart of it. We invite you to be a part of this exciting journey and to partner with us in faith and see what God can do. In one month, the faith of five people saw a 200% increase. Will you prayerfully consider how you can join with us and multiply the \$100 seed to at least double the return at the end of the month?





COMPLETED RENOVATIONS IN 2023

Last year we saw the completion of several key renovations and improvements within our church:

- 1. After selling our previous 2007 Toyota Hiace commuter we purchased a brand new 2023 Toyota Hiace commuter (automatic) and launched our bus ministry once again. Our bus ministry became dormant since COVID-19. We are thankful for the 5 men who volunteer there time each month to help and assist those struggling to get to church on any given Sunday.
- 2. At the bottom carpark we built a designated 'car park structure' to protect and shelter the new church bus and Hino truck from the harsh Australian elements. Within the last decade we have experienced rather significant damage and rust to our church vehicles due to being constantly outside.
- 3. We changed all of our auditorium and kids church lighting to efficient LED lights from the old halogen bulbs. We also had these specifically wired to be 'dimmable' enabling us to dim the lights during worship and other segments where it would be preferable. This cost was \$5000 for the new LED lights and installation.
- 4. We updated our main auditorium air conditioning due to being under powered from the initial installation. After research and several professional calculations we only had 80kw of air-conditioning within our auditorium. Last year we added a total of 56kw of extra air-conditioning consisting of 4x Samsung cassette units. This expense was \$25,423.20 with installation
- 5. Due to the rapid growth of babies and children within our church we built a new designated mothers room consisting of four rocking chairs, two private feeding cubicles with chairs and a TV to watch the service live. This expense was \$5,000 consisting of air-conditioning.

RENOVATIONS IN 2024

We endeavour to carry our church with a 'spirit of excellence'. We want our facilities to reflect to our community that we care we also desire to steward what God has placed within our hands knowing that God will bless us with more. Our building facilitates various departments and ministries within any given week as we use this building as a tool for God's Kingdom. Although a building is insignificant without its people, our facilities continue to be a place that houses God's people.

This year we are planning to prioritise the following renovations:

CHILDREN'S CHURCH:

Our Children's ministry easily doubled in size in 2023 due to the continued growth of families within our church alongside many new families joining our fellowship. We have been renovating various room within our Kids church to better make space of there general areas, storage rooms and a general tidy up.

CRÈCHE:

Of recent months we have noticed a substantial need for 'creche' once again, it has been over 8+ years since we last had this department running for children 4 years and under. Crèche is a department within children's church that allows parents with children under the age of 4 to be supervised in a specific tailed zone during the morning service. This allows parents (whom don't have much rest) to attend church and be present, take in worship and the message and receive on any given Sunday.

We have started renovating and building this room next door to the indoor playground, this will ensure all our Children's facilities are within reach of each other and easily accessible and recognisable.

CHILDREN'S COMMON AREA:

Outside the 'indoor playground and new crèche room' we have a common area that we'll be renovating this year to match the decor of our main auditorium and kids auditorium. This year in 2024, we are planning to replace the old carpet, continue painting all the walls and skirting, remove the old bible collage reception desk and turn an old storage room into a 'children's specific toilet'. With the rapid growth of kids church we want to build and renovate this area to better meet the need for better rooms and facilities. Having a toilet on that Childrens side of the building will do several things:

- Stop children running through the auditorium or better yet, not making it to the toilet in time.
- Having a specific low lying children's toilet and sink, whilst creating a better management plan for transporting children to the toilet with our leaders.

TOILETS:

We would like to renovate our main toilets later in 2024. We would like to update the toilet corridor and toilets with new tiles in the bathrooms, partition walls, toilets and sinks. We have endeavoured to make this renovation happen but have had greater priorities within the last 18 months of recent renovations.

We ask you to prayerfully considering how you can partner with us this year in 2024. God is moving among us in Logan city and beyond. We are so thankful for your generosity and heart for this house as we continue to make space and steward was God has entrusted us.



BUILDING PROJECT

In early 2023 we were able to confirm the future of our new and current building from being consumed by the 'Department of Transport and Main Roads' for future development. There were concerns and a preliminary evaluation to consume our property as a whole, repurposing it for the Pacific Motorway M1 upgrade from Daisy Hill to the Logan Motorway. After an in person meeting and by God's grace the future development plan will build around our entire church allowing us to keep our land and building from any future developments by DTMR.

After this much anticipated news we resumed the building approvals and processes in 2023 for our progressive new church building. After 12+ months of going back and forth with Energex, changing electrical plans and meeting there specific criteria we finally got approval in November of 2023. After this approval we completed all underground works to power the 'current building' from the 'new church buildings power'. Our electrical meters are planing to be installed by Energex mid February of this year.

This year in 2024 we are currently working towards having the following completed by the end of 2024

- 1. Electrical meter installed by Energex and cabinet metering (outside) installed
- Rough in/installation of power to the 'foyer, toilets and connecting offices'
- 3. Plumbing rough in for toilets, sewerage connection, plumbing approval, hydraulic design plans, pressure testing and final approvals.
- 4. Double sided steel stair case built and certified on the 'western' entrance to the new church fover
- 5. Gyprock to the church foyer, toilets and joining offices
- Flood approval with Logan City Council that consists of the following work:
 Hydraulic flood design plans, initial flood modelling, amended LCC flood
 modelling, flood report, flood emergency management
 plan and final approvals with LCC

Invoices that have been 'paid' so far:

- Excavation/underground power cables (67m) to power the old building from the new building - \$4,956.00
- 2. Energex meter/circuit cabinets outside \$21,022.76
- 3. Plumbing rough in for all toilets, sewerage connection, plumbing approval, hydraulic design plans, pressure testing and final approvals \$56,155.00
- 4. Double sided steel stair case to the 'western' foyer entrance \$25,000

Funds 'to be raised' in 2024:

- Flood approval with Logan City Council that consists of the following work: Hydraulic flood design plans, initial flood modelling, amended LCC flood modelling, flood report, flood emergency management plan and final approvals with LCC - \$49,437.50
- 2. Electrical rough in and fit off for the foyer, toilets and joining offices \$ TBC
- Certification for the double sided stair case to the 'western' foyer entrance -\$ TBC
- 4. Gyprock for the foyer, toilets and joining offices \$ TBC

Our goal is to have the new foyer completed and occupied by the end of 2025. This completion will see the relocation of our 8am chapel service to the new church foyer with it's own designated facility to host the 8am Sunday service.

Since the birth of Dunamis Church in June of 1992 we've had one mission - to bring those who are far from God, close to Him. As we enter another year of building our new building, pressing towards the legacy of occupying that God ordained building, this is what we hold fast to. Building brick by brick for generations to come. We believe as we continue to make space, God will make a way.

Dunamis Community Food was first birthed five years ago from a desire to see our community blessed and touched by the unconditional love of God. What first began as a dream and a idea through Pastor Danny and Melissa quickly grew into a permanent shop behind our Church cafe that is open every Sunday from 8:30am to 11am.

Over the past 3 years we've seen families within our community struggle financially as the cost of living continues to climb. Pushing families into financial and physical pressure as the affordability of life soars with fuel, groceries, expenditures and a national rental crisis.

The Dunamis Community Pantry is a place where our community at large can purchase affordable regular household items, pantry and general food whilst being loved and cared for by our church volunteers.

Pastor Danny and Melissa mentioned: Our community food outreach continues this year to bless many families within our local community and church community alike. In addition to the pantry being open on a weekly basis, we continue to provide free food hampers to women and families in domestic violence refuges, local community centres, and the Queensland Police and Youth Justice. The Tanah Merah Community Markets first took place on Saturday 10th August 2019. What was once an idea to simply reach our own backyard and community, to welcome people to our church without feeling confrontational about church. What a journey God has brought us through over the years, every month we've seen hundreds of unsaved people venture to what might seem minor or irrelevant. We've seen God's hand through this market in the wildest ways, to church tours for people wanting to know more, to stall holders coming to a Sunday service and creating a community where visions feel safe, loved and valued.

Through the running of the monthly markets we will endeavour to provide ways to give back to the community.

- 1. Fresh Produce will continue to be our staple at each market, offering a variety of fresh local food ranging from fruits, vegetables, eggs, honey and so much more. From local farmers and markets we are able source and offer the community of Logan City lower priced produce than any store or retail giant. Through the generosity of member of our church each month, we are able to subsidise cost to bring savings to our community and those struggling.
- 2. Dunamis Community Food exists to provide non-perishable products ranging from \$0.50 to \$5.00. Through our partnership with a vast range of distribution centres we have been able to provide non-perishable/pantry items that are in date and straight from the warehouse.
- 3. The Tanah Merah Community Markets have helped bring the neighbourhood together, through a sense of community, support and encouragement. We have been able to provide a vessel that God uses each month in bringing everyone from all walks of life together. Our market is continually reviewed as a place that is safe, friendly and welcoming.

Matthew 5:14-16 (ESV) "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

DUNAMIS School of Ministries

Over 10 years ago as a church we had a Bible called Dunamis International College of Ministries. In 2022 from a call and a mandate to raise leaders with theological understanding we decided to have a soft launch for our new college 'Dunamis School of Ministries'. We pray college will develop men and women to discover their God given identity and calling. Be disciples in theological truths and clear understanding of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. That these men and women would disperse and be sent out into their divine purpose.

The courses on offer will include the following: Christian Education, Christian Ethics, Christology, Church History, Church Growth, Church Leadership, Church Planting 1, Church Planting 2, Evangelism & Outreach, Hermeneutics, Homiletics - Biblical Preaching & Teaching, Missiology, New Testament 1, New Testament 2, Old Testament 1, Old Testament 2, Pastoral Care, Pneumatology, Revival History, Systematic Theology 1, Systematic Theology 2, World Cults, World Religions and Worship.

Students will graduate with a Certificate of Completion for each year of Dunamis School of Ministries. We decided to not make this college not an accredited school to provide affordability to everyone desiring to grow deeper in their theology of God. The Certificates of Completion are recognised by other ministries and churches.
