RENOVTIONS

POSTPONED RENOVATIONS IN 2022

After launching Vision Sunday in 2022 we were hopeful to continue renovations throughout our church facility after achieving vast accomplishments in 2021 throughout our auditorium. On Friday 25th February 2022 we were hit with the unexpected. The rain never ceased by Tropical Cyclone Debbie and flood waters continued to climb spontaneously like 2017 and 2019. What was once reiterated as a 'once in a 100 year flood', we saw record numbers broken in 2022 with flood water reaching over 2m in height in our Church basement.

By the help of our community and experience from this being our third flood to unfold in 5 years, we cleaned and bounced back in a matter of 7 days. Unfortunately, this flood led to a multitude of repairs such as flooded circuit boards, power points, various skip bins and other expenses. This unexpected event led us to pay over \$40,000 of expenses until our insurance payout was finalised 7 months post flood.

In 2022 we finished the remaining renovations in our Kids Church:

- Laying carpet tiles 180^{m2} \$1,683.00
- Carpet removal \$1,250.48
- 180^{m2} Carpet tiles (covered by the extra tiles from the auditorium renovation)



RENOVATIONS IN 2023

We endeavour to conduct our church with a 'spirit of excellence'. We want our facilities to reflect to our community that we *care*, we also desire to steward what God has placed within our hands. Our church facilities are used several times a week in various ways as a tool for God's work. Although a building is insignificant without its people, our facilities continue to be a place that houses God's people. This year we have already completed the following:

CHURCH VEHICLE PROTECTION: At the bottom of our church carpark we built a designated car park structure to specifically protect our Hino truck and 12 seater bus from the Australian harsh elements. Over the years we had significant rust and damage to church vehicles due to being outside in the sun constantly (Unfortunately, these two vehicles are too tall to fit under the church basement).



NEW TOYOTA HIACE BUS: We just acquired a new Toyota Hiace (12 seater) bus after selling our previous bus, that we owned since 2007. We are excited that this new bus will be protected from any future costly paint expenses from being stored permanently outside. Our new bus is able to be driven with a regular car license and is our first ever automatic bus that we have owned. We hope this helps more drivers wanting to serve a ministry or department who were restricted due to not having a manual car license.







LED AUDITORIUM LIGHTS: For the past 18 months we have been working towards replacing all lights in our building to LED high bay lights. This consists of our main auditorium, kids church and the kids church common area. The existing mercury lights in the auditorium by law was phased out in 2022 and left us unable to purchase replacement bulbs in the future. Last year we were able to start in our smaller areas and change over Kids Church and their common area to LED. This year in February 2023 we replaced our Church Auditorium with twelve LED high bay lights that are now dimmable and controllable from the sound desk. This cost was \$5000 for the lights and installation.

ADDITIONAL AIR-CONDITIONING IN THE AUDITORIUM: Many have noticed that our auditorium airconditioning has always struggled keeping up with the Australian summer. In December 2022 one of those 20kw ducted unit's broke down with an intermittent problem, leaving us with one aircon system broken down during the peak season. This aircon unit will be repaired finally by Samsung mid March, only costing us several thousand instead of replacing the whole unit for \$15,000.

After some research and calculations we also discovered that the Air-conditioning capacity for the size of our auditorium should have been doubled, yet we only had 80kw of air-conditioning installed in 2016. We were able to find a wise and smart solution to get more kilowatts in our auditorium with outing spending excess amounts on new ductinging. We have recently added 56kw of more air-conditioning through 'four cassette units', which consists of two units at the front and two at the back of the auditorium. These 'cassette units' have been working very effectively in our Kids church and will save us ten's of thousands of dollars just on ducting alone. This expense was \$25,423.20 (4x 14kw cassette units with installation in our auditorium)

KIDS CHURCH COMMON AREA: After completing the Kids church auditorium renovation in 2022 we renovated the carpet to match our main auditorium and installed Air-conditioning in the children's facility. We're looking to follow through with the common area of Kids Church by firstly tearing down the old Bible college reception desk that has not been used professionally for over 10 years. This will create matching carpet that flows from our auditorium, kids church and common area that leads to the mothers room, playground and teaching rooms that are used every Sunday.

MOTHERS ROOM: Due to the growth of Kids church over the past 6 months, numbers have come close to doubling in size which leads to a lack of space in teaching rooms. We are creating a new purpose built mothers room right next to the auditorium for easy access and better privacy. This new mothers room will contain purpose built feeding cubicles behind curtains, a wash area for bottles, a microwave and rocking chairs. The existing mothers room at the back of the common area will be used for extra teaching rooms for the growing diversity of kids each Sunday.

CHURCH STAGE: In continuation of our recent auditorium renovation in 2021, we will endeavour to renovate our stage shape, design and material. We have been planning a new stage design to make our stage bigger, more presentable and complimenting our recent renovation of our carpet, paint and chairs.

Prayerfully consider partnering with us this year in 2023, as we endeavour to take more ground upon our church as a whole. God is moving among us in Logan city and beyond. We are so thankful for your generosity and heart for this house.

NEW BUILDING PROJECT



Towards the end of 2022 we were able to confirm the future of our new and current building from being consumed by the 'Department of Transport and Main Roads' for future development. There were concerns and a preliminary evaluation to consume our property as a whole, repurposing it for the Pacific Motorway M1 upgrade from Daisy Hill to the Logan Motorway. After an in-person meeting at the DTMR head office in Nerang last October, by God's goodness and faithfulness we will continue to stay within our property. Free from any further developments or plans to develop our property as part of the M1 upgrade in the near future. God is faithful. His promises will always be yes and amen! To the left is a photo ('concept for consultation' of the works to be conducted around our property in the near future').

With this confirmation sorted with the 'Department of Transport and Main Roads' we are endeavouring to resume the continual planning and approvals to build our new foyer, toilets and various room's behind the current kid's church facility. This year in 2023 we aim to finalise and establish the electrical fit-out, have completed the electrical meters and connection to the new building and the plumbing fit-out for the toilets. Whilst obtaining all necessary approvals to achieve our 'foyer' completion goal by the end of 2024. Next year in 2024 we're praying all fit-outs will be complete to begin the finishing stage of the new building, such as gyprock, paint, carpet and the final fit-out. Our goal is to have the new foyer complete and occupied within 2 years from today. This completion will see the relocation of our 8am chapel service to the new church foyer, with it's own designated facility to host this specific Sunday service.

To help achieve this goal for the new building we are forming a 'building project team' (as per the Church Board's request) who will offer professional and intentional advice. This team will work together to achieve our goal of occupancy for our 8am service. This board will contain, but not limited to the following members:

- Josiah Hansen Secretary Ordained Minister (Board member)
- Colin Street Director Building Project (Board member)
- Andrew Hannam Business owner Electrical engineer

We look forward to seeing the development of our new building progress into all that God has spoken and promised us. We believe that what God started, He will complete!



Dunamis Community Food was first birthed four years ago from a desire to see our community blessed and touched by the unconditional love of God. What first began as a dream and a idea through Pastor Danny and Melissa has grown into a permanent shop behind our Church cafe that is open every Sunday from 8:30am to 11am.

Over the past 2 years we've seen families within our community first hand struggle as the cost of living continues to climb. Pushing families into financial and physical pressure as the affordability of living soars with fuel, groceries, expenditures and a rental crisis. The Dunamis Community Pantry is a place where our community at large can purchase affordable regular household items, pantry and general food whilst being loved and cared for by our church volunteers.

Pastor Danny and Melissa mentioned: We are excited for our Community Food outreach program for 2023. In January 2023 we successfully finished the building of our new permanent pantry, open to both the community and our church family. Pastors Danny and Melissa have a heart for the community and believe through this ministry we can pour Gods unconditional love to the lost in our city. The pantry will be open regularly on a weekly basis along with the monthly Tanah Merah Community Markets. We also provide regular food hampers to people in need in our community along with the Youth Justice Police Response team in Logan City. The Tanah Merah Community Markets first took place on Saturday 10th August 2019. What a journey God has brought us through over the years, every month we've seen hundreds of unsaved people venture to our church market. We've seen God's hand through this market in the wildest ways, from church tours for people wanting to know more, to stall holders coming to a Sunday service and creating a community where visitors feel safe, loved and valued.

Our market reviews have shown that people love the Tanah Merah Community Markets, we've received many reviews stating we are a friendly, caring and loving place to stroll through. We pray that this market continues to be a vessel that God uses for His glory. Through the running of the monthly markets we will endeavour to provide ways to give back to the community.

- 1. Fresh Produce will continue to be our staple at each market, offering a variety of fresh local food ranging from fruits, vegetables, eggs, honey and so much more. From local farmers and markets we are able to source and offer the community of Logan City lower priced produce than any store or retail giant. Through the generosity of our church each month we are able to subsidise cost to bring savings to our community and those struggling.
- 2. Dunamis Community Food exists to provide non-perishable products ranging from \$0.50 to \$5.00. Through our partnerships we have been able to provide nonperishable/pantry items that are in date and straight from the warehouse.
- 3. The Tanah Merah Community Markets have helped bring the neighbourhood together, through a sense of community, support and encouragement. We have been able to provide a vessel that God uses each month in bringing everyone from all walks of life together. Our market is continually reviewed as a place that is safe, friendly and welcoming.

DUNAMIS School of Winistries









Over 10 years ago as a church we had a Bible college called Dunamis International College of Ministries. In 2022 from a call and a mandate to raise leaders with theological understanding we decided to have a soft launch for our new school 'Dunamis School of Ministries'. We pray that men and women discover their God given identity. Through Dunamis School of ministries we pray each student is discipled in theological truths and the gifts of the Holy Spirit to be dispersed and sent out into their divine purpose.

The courses on offer will include the following: Christian Education, Christian Ethics, Christology, Church History, Church Growth, Church Leadership, Church Planting 1, Church Planting 2, Evangelism & Outreach, Hermeneutics, Homiletics - Biblical Preaching & Teaching, Missiology, New Testament 1, New Testament 2, Old Testament 1, Old Testament 2, Pastoral Care, Pneumatology, Revival History, Systematic Theology 1, Systematic Theology 2, World Cults, World Religions and Worship.

Students will graduate with a Certificate of Completion for each year of Dunamis School of Ministries. We decided to not make this an accredited school to provide affordability to everyone desiring to grow deeper in their theology of God. The Certificates of Completion are recognised by other ministries and churches. 2 Corinthians 9:10 (NASB)

CHILDREN'S CHURCH


